To the National Ski Associations interested in participating in the FIS Roller Ski Asian Cup Competition in PyeongChang, Republic of Korea, in 2025, Korea Ski & Snowboard Association cordially invites your nation to participate in the FIS Roller Ski Asian Cup, which will be held from August 4 to 6, 2025, at the Alpensia Cross-Country Centre in PyeongChang, Republic of Korea.

We extend our warmest welcome to all participants joining us for this exciting event.

The competition will take place at the Alpensia Cross-Country Centre and the Biathlon Centre, both situated at an elevation of 700 meters above sea level. These venues successfully hosted the PyeongChang 2018 Olympic Winter Games and the Gangwon 2024 Winter Youth Olympic Games, and they offer world-class infrastructure that meets international standards. Renowned for its cool climate even in midsummer, Daegwallyeong is considered one of Korea's most pleasant summer destinations.

Nearby, just a 40-minute drive away, lies the coastal city of Gangneung, famously known as the "City of Coffee." Venue Information: This venue hosted the PyeongChang 2018 Winter Olympics and the Gangwon 2024 Winter Youth Olympic Games, and has also been the site of annual national roller ski competitions. The roller ski course consists of two loops: 1 km and 2.5 km.

Request for Team Information for Participation

In preparation for your team's participation in the competition, we kindly request the following information:

- 1. Flight details: including arrival and departure times and dates
- 2. Accommodation details : number of people, dates of stay, and number of rooms required
- 3. Meal information : number of people, dates, and the number of meals required

This information will be shared with the hotel, restaurant, and transportation service providers to support coordination. Please note that all related costs must be borne by each team. The Organizing Committee (OC) will only facilitate hotel room reservations and meal arrangements with the respective service providers.

4. For transportation: The Organizing Committee will support the transport of athletes to and from the Games and transport to the venue.

Accommodations and Meals

We would like to extend our sincere appreciation to all participating teams and athletes in the FIS Roller Ski Asian Cup 2025.

To ensure a pleasant and comfortable stay throughout the competition, we are pleased to provide detailed information regarding accommodation and meals for all team officials and athletes.

Kindly note that accommodation fees are to be paid upon check-in, and meal expenses should be settled directly at the restaurant at the time of dining. Payment is accepted by card and Korean cash.

Transportation

The Organizing Committee will support the transport of athletes to and from the Games and transport to the venue.

For the arrival dates, 31st of July, 1st of August and 2nd of August, the organization will provide transport from the airport to the accommodation on those dates. For the departure dates, 6th of August and 7th of August, the organization will provide transport from the accommodation to the airport on those dates.

- 1. For teams arriving on a day when the Organizing Committee does not provide an arrival and departure service, international taxis are available. If you would like to use an international taxi, please request it in the last question of the Google Form.
- 2. International taxi service that provides direct transportation from the airport to the accommodation.

For direct transportation from the airport to the accommodation via international taxi, the following options are available:

Pre-Competition Checklist

Please review the following information and check all items once confirmed.

- 1. Competition Registration
- Participating teams must complete the FIS online entry form and submit it via email to furumelee@naver.com by the registration deadline.
- 2. Entry Fee Payment
- No entrée fee
- 3. Equipment Preparation
- All participants are required to bring their own roller skis, helmet, goggles, gloves, boots, and other personal equipment.
- The Organizing Committee will provide official Classic(Marwe), Free(FF) roller skis for official training and competition days.
- 4. Team Captains' Meeting (TCM)
- Competition-related information will be provided during the Team Captains' Meeting on August 3, and attendance by the team representative is mandatory.
- 5. Accident & Insurance
- In the event of an accident at the venue, first aid and hospital transport will be provided. However, any further medical treatment at the hospital must be paid for by the injured person.
- The Organizing Committee has arranged event insurance, but all participants must also have their own personal insurance coverage.
