Participants

1. Each National Ski Association from Asian region may enter an unlimited number of athletes per each FIS ROL Asian Cup competition.
2. NSA not from the Asian region (according to p2.1) may enter an unlimited number of athletes, but they do not score Asian Cup points.
3. The OC may apply an entry fee to athletes outside of the national team (maximum CHF 10 in local currency equivalent per athlete per competition). Each nation has a national team quota of eight (8) athletes per category per ROLAC competition day which are not subject of an entry fee. The names of these athletes must be announced to the OC in the entries.
4. Only National Ski Associations are entitled to send entries for the ROLAC or ROLASC. Entries made by e.g. individual athletes, ski clubs or private teams cannot be accepted.

All Athletes, male and female must have valid FIS code. Entry must be sent by the official FIS application form + must indicate type of ski bindings (SNS / NNN) for each athlete.

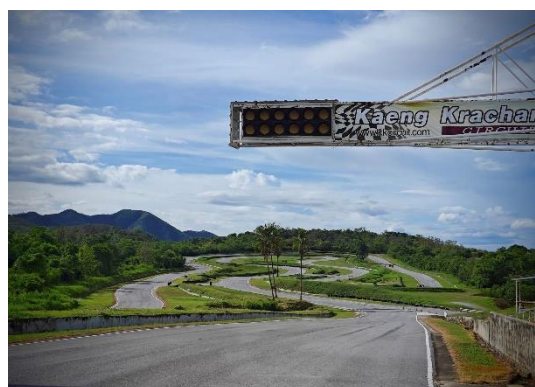

- Any competition that includes international athletes will be recognized as an “International race” and will count towards the medal tally for their respective countries.
- Athletes registering under an international club’s will have their results aggregated under their National team’s name.
- In NC Local competitions, if no international athletes participate, the results will be counted toward the overall medal tally of each province's teams in Thailand.
- Athletes must compete in accordance with the designated age categories.
- Coaches must attend the Technical Meeting (TCM) for every event prior to the competition.

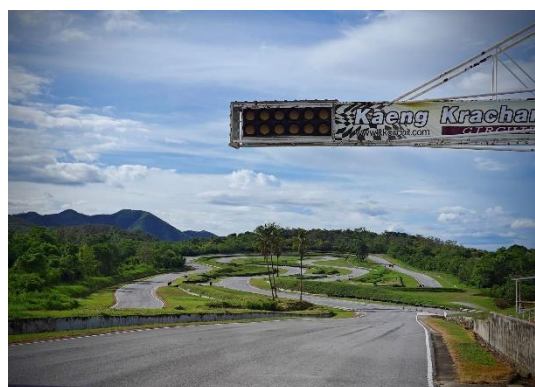
